## LOSING JESUS

Luke 2.41-52

3 Lessons we can learn from Luke's story about Mary and Joseph losing Jesus.

1. Don't assume that Jesus is ALWAYS WITH YOU.

After the festival was over, while his parents were returning home, the boy Jesus stayed behind in Jerusalem, **but they were unaware of it.** v. 43

3. When you do meet him again, be prepared for him to say or do <u>THE UNEXPECTED</u>.

When his parents saw him, they were astonished. v. 48 But they did not understand what he was saying to them. v. 50

**DISCIPLESHIP** always involves the unexpected.

## 2. If you sense Jesus is missing from your life go looking for him <u>WHERE HE HANGS OUT</u>.

"Why were you searching for me?" he asked. "Didn't you know I had to be in my Father's business?" v. 49

"Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you something to drink? When did we see you a stranger and invite you in, or needing clothes and clothe you? When did we see you sick or in prison and go to visit you?' "The King will reply, 'Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, **you did for me.**'" Matthew 25.37-40
